
Centre for Health Innovation vision; "together for future health services"

The Centre for Health Innovation seeks, together with its owners, partners and the community to find new sustainable solutions to national health challenges through knowledge, research, development and innovation.




Centre for Health Innovation; society task and role

Research, development and innovation Knowledge, user participation and identified needs

Centre for Health Innovation; strategy (2019-2023)

Centre for Health Innovation will contribute to the development and introduction of knowledge, new innovative solutions, products and services that are of high quality and resource-giving to the society, its citizens and the public health care services.

The centre will contribute through:

- Integration
 - Invite, initiate, carry out and lead cross professional projects, offer process support, be an interaction arena, contribute to increased competence and knowledge
- Research collaboration
 - Connect health practices to the research fields efficiently through translation research and systems science. Job training and transfer of expertise are central
- Interaction with regional educational and health actors
 - Strong connection to Campus Kristiansund and District Medical Center (DMS) in order to develop and implement new, need-driven and user-centered health care services through research-driven innovation
- Across industries technology and process
 - Coordinate, and be the laboratory for testing of new technology, methods, tools and services



Centre for Health Innovation; organizational form

Centre for Health Innovation runs from temporary project to permanent operation in 2019. To build the center further and facilitate further growth, a process has been initiated that includes new organization, ownership and management. New form of organization is adopted in the spring of 2019



Co-financing model of the Centre for Health Innovation

1: Government funds to safeguard the center's social mission

2: Project financing of social assignments by applying social funds carried out by the Centre of Health Innovation with partners and collaborators

3: Own financing from owners and partners

All resources provided to the Centre for Health Innovation are transferred back to owners, partners and the society in the form of new collaboration, new health- and welfare technology, new research and knowledge, new solutions and services, improved and adapted education and better public health.
